## Project Description:

Mountain Methods, Inc., performed as the Prime Contractor on this USDA Forest Service Project. This project involved the demolition of two asbestos containing buildings, permanent abandonment of septic system, and restoration of surrounding area to natural conditions. The buildings were within a recreational residence tract at Brightman Meadows, in the Summit Ranger District, Stanislaus National Forest.

## Problems Encountered and Corrective Actions Taken:

Located in the high country of the Highway 108 corridor, the project took careful planning and coordination of trucking and mobilization. Both structures involved in the demolition contained asbestos. MMI coordinated with a hazmat certified subcontractor to remove the asbestos containing material. The project required the off haul of debris to a certified landfill.
