Technical Performance:

Crews installed approximately 30 feet of new 6” Class 200 water line, and a Clow 850 Fire Hydrant with isolation valves at Coast Guard Island, Alameda. All work done under this project required water shut downs impacting the entire island. A clear, concise schedule was followed in order to minimize shut downs for the Coast Guard. Physical location of existing underground utilities, traffic control, and site security were all requirements for this project. Work was completed both during and after normal operating hours to minimize impact to the government.

Safety topics for this project included traffic control, trench safety, hand and arm signals, working around equipment, emergency contacts, and heat casualty. Project was finished without any injuries or illness, on time, and within budget.
